Conflict Materials Sourcing Policy

In response to violence and human rights violations in the mining of certain minerals from the “Conflict Region”, which is situated in the eastern portion of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries, Feller has adopted rules to implement reporting and disclosure requirements related to “conflict minerals”.

The rules require manufacturers who disclose whether the products they manufacture or contract to manufacture contain “conflict minerals” that are “necessary to the functionality or production” of those products.

The definition of “conflict minerals” refers to gold, as well as tin, tantalum, and tungsten, regardless of where they are sourced, processed or sold.

We support the humanitarian goal of ending violent conflict in the DRC and surrounding countries.

We are committed to the responsible sourcing of “conflict minerals” throughout our supply chain.
